 - Affirmation of Service
- 2. The motion is returnable only on Mondays.
- 3. Service: 8 days' notice is required for personal service;

13 days' notice is required for service by mail.

The day of service is not counted.

For example: If you personally serve your papers on your adversary on May 1st, the earliest

date you can make your motion returnable is May 9th.

- 4. The Legal Aid Society Juvenile Rights Division as well as the agency's attorney should be served with a copy of the motion.
- 5. The order/judgment appealed from may be obtained from your lawyer or the Family Court.
